



THE HUMAN BRAIN

The central sulcus divides the front from the back.
 All of the cortex in front of the central sulcus is Frontal Cortex.

This diagram shows only the surface of the brain and so it only shows cortical areas. Subcortical areas (such as the Amygdala, Basal Ganglia, and Hypothalamus) are buried safely underneath the cortex and are therefore less vulnerable to damage from blows to the head.
